#### Notes FYI:

The Essex Steam Train & Riverboat is a one-of-a-kind attraction in Connecticut offering a chartered stream train and riverboat excursion, round-trip into the heart of the Connecticut River Valley. The best way to make room reservations at the Holiday Inn Express & Suites is to call the hotel and state it is under group code SFR for the "Samuel Family Reunion" block to receive the discounted group rates. Room reservations must be made by May 30, 2024, by credit card to receive the group discount. The confirmation number will be emailed or given to you over the phone. The Holiday Inn Express & Suites is located a few minutes off I-95, exit 40. Across the street from the Holiday Inn Express is the Hilton Garden Inn (a hotel used at a prior reunion).

For those who find time and/or extend their stay in Connecticut (Thursday – Sunday) the Connecticut Post Mall, the largest mall in Connecticut, 1201 Boston Post Road, is located a short walk/drive from the Holiday Inn Express. The Boston Post Road has a variety of shopping outlets, stores, and restaurants, for your convenience. Other nearby attractions, (on your own) include the Mohegan Sun Casino & Resort (approximately 1 hour 10-minute drive from the hotel via I-95 N) and the Foxwoods Resort Casino (approximately 1 hour and a half hour drive from the hotel via I-95 N).

#### The Aaron and Charlie Samuel Memorial Scholarship Fund Eligibility Requirements and Application Guidelines

## Eligibility for this scholarship requires that the applicant:

- Must be a legitimate heir of the Samuel Family, and descendants and relatives of "Grandpa Charlie Samuel."
- Must be currently accepted or enrolled in a program of study leading to a post-secondary certificate or professional degree from a two-year or fouryear college, university, or technical institution of higher learning.
- You must be enrolled as a full-time student. All applicants may re-apply up to age 25.
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- Must submit verification of academic standing by a letter of acceptance from the institution of higher learning or the most recent transcript of grades.
- Must have a current grade point average of 2.0 or better on a 4-point academic scale or a 3.0 or better on 5-point academic scale.
- Must be sponsored by a local chapter of the Samuel Family Reunion.
- Must have attended a family reunion at least 3 years of the 5 years prior to the application year.
- Must submit a 350-500 word original essay on the importance of knowing your family history and how this knowledge has impacted your life and chosen career path. Please include how your attendance at the reunions has influenced your attitudes and values.
- Must submit a completed application form with the signature of the President or designee of the sponsoring chapter.
- The dollar amount of scholarships awarded will be determined by the Scholarship Committee and based on the funds available. Applications are evaluated based on eligibility requirements and adherence to application guidelines. Essays are evaluated on a common writing rubric established by the Scholarship Committee.
